MADRID	<p><b>FULL DAY TOLEDO + ROYAL MONASTERY OF THE ESCORIAL WITH LUNCH</b></p> <p>The beautiful imperial city-museum of Toledo “World Heritage City” is located 70km away from Madrid. It is one of the oldest towns in Europe, called “city of the three cultures”, since Christians, Muslims and Jews lived together. Its genuine Spanish buildings include almost all the periods in the history (Arab, Gothic, Mudejar, Renaissance and Baroque style). 	<p><b>FULL DAY AVILA &amp; SEGOVIA WITH LUNCH</b></p> <p><b>ÁVILA</b> : Sta Teresa de Jesús, a great mystic woman of the Catholic Church, was born in this city which conserves the most ancient and complete fortified complex in Spain (XI century). Its 2500 m wall and its 90 fortified towers surround the old city, which houses great part of its monumental treasure including a large number of Romanesque style churches, gothic palaces and a fortified cathedral of the XII century.</p> <p><b>SEGOVIA</b>: The roman empire left in Segovia the Acueduct, which is 16 km long. It was residence of some of the kings of Castilia and preserves one of the most important medieval group of buildings in Spain.
